Merry Mole, Pinot Grigio MOLDOVA 7 - 9 - 25

Merry Mole's mascot is inspired by Moldova's underground cellars, where wines age in cool, natural conditions.

C'est La Vie, Chardonnay, Sauvignon FRANCE 8 - 11 - 29

Albert Bichot won 'White Wine Maker of the Year' in the International Wine Challenge. Trust us - this is the best Chardonnay you'll ever taste.

Picpoul de Pinet FRANCE 9 - 12 - 35

Picpoul means lip stinger. Named for its acidity that wakes your mouth up for seafood.

La Sablette Muscadet FRANCE 9 - 12 - 35

Bottled seaside, crisp, salty, made for seafood.

Viognier Waddesdon Rothschild FRANCE 9 - 12 - 36

The Rothschild-curated Viognier is harvested at night to protect its delicate white-flower aromatics.

Waddling Duck Sauvignon Blanc NEW ZEALAND 10 - 13 - 38

Waddling Duck gets its name from the ducks that wander through Marlborough vineyards.

Gavi di Gavi ITALY 11 - 15 - 39

It's nicknamed 'the Italian aperitif' wine, so fresh it's designed to make you order another.

Reisling, 'Hochgewächs', Weingut Otto Gorgen GERMANY 10 - 14 - 41

A superior Mosel Riesling from hand-tended slate slopes - crisp, citrus-led and beautifully mineral.

Pierre Andre Chablis FRANCE 11 - 15 - 43

Made from zero oak, letting the region's ancient seashell-rich soils give it that crisp, flinty, salty edge.

Domaine Rossignole Sancerre FRANCE 12 - 17 - 50

After an epidemic wiped red Sancerre out, growers replanted with the Sauvignon Blanc - turns out the vineyard apocalypse accidentally created a superstar.

7 - 9 - 25

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Recas Pinot Noir

8 - 10 - 29

Grows just a few miles from where the Romans first planted vines, 2,000 years ago.

Baron d'Arignac Cabernet Sauvignon

8 - 10 - 30

Baron d'Arignac was invented as a 'fake aristocrat' so French wine could conquer the world - turns out a made-up baron travels very well.

Putruele Malbec ARGENTINA

9 - 11 - 32

Putruele grows Malbec at altitude so the grapes sunbathe all day and cool off at night - Argentina's secret.

Shiraz 'M' Mallee Estate AUSTRALIA

9 - 13 - 38

Mallee Estate's 'M' Shiraz comes from some of South Australia's oldest family-run vineyards - the brothers behind it still hand-craft every vintage themselves.

Demuerte Gold SPAIN

11 - 15 - 43

Demuerte borrows 'Day of the Dead' symbolism to celebrate life - skull bottle outside, seriously good Spanish red inside.

Chateau Perron Pomerol FRANCE

12 - 16 - 48

Merlot from iron-rich blue clay, all plush texture, quiet power, and serious pedigree in a small postcode.

Châteauneuf du Pape FRANCE

14 - 20 - 60

Châteauneuf-du-Pape once banned flying saucers from its vineyards - an official law still on the books.



ROSÉ

Merry Mole Pinot Blush MOLDOVA

7 - 9 - 25

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Rose D'Anjou La Bougrie FRANCE

8 - 11 - 32

Rosé d'Anjou is naturally off-dry – the Loire's Cabernet grapes keep a touch of sweetness that makes it ridiculously easy to drink.

Ma Terre Provence Rosé FRANCE

9 - 13 - 38

Picked early and barely touches the grape skins, which is why it stays pale, crisp, and dangerously easy to drink.

Whispering Angel FRANCE

14 - 21 - 42

Whispering Angel helped redefine modern rose by treating it with the same care as fine white wine.

SPARKLING

Glass - Btl

Simpatico Prosecco FRANCE

7 - 28

Prosecco is made with the Glera grape, a variety so old it was once called "the grape of joy."

Joseph Perrier Brut FRANCE

13 - 75

Once favoured by Queen Victoria and King Edward VII, earning its nickname 'The King's Champagne'.

Joseph Perrier Rosé FRANCE

16 - 90

Their cellars are carved into ancient Roman chalk tunnels.

Moët FRANCE

15 - 90

Moët & Chandon owns the largest Champagne cellar in the world, stretching over 17 miles beneath Épernay.

Veuve Clicquot FRANCE

16 - 95

Madame Clicquot was one of the first female entrepreneurs in history, taking over the Champagne house at just 27.

Bollinger FRANCE

16 - 95

James Bond's Champagne of choice.
